CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The application included on the reverse side hereof is subject to acceptance by the Ping Pro-Pro, and applicant agrees that in the event of acceptance, it may be rejected or revoked at any time thereafter. To be accepted, entries must be signed, paid, and received at tournament headquarters. Therefore, players submitting entries are encouraged to allow ample time for delay or error in transmission of their entries.

Both the said Application and the Applicant's participation in aforesaid event are subject to all Rules, Regulations, provisions of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Pacific NW Section, PGA of America and other conditions applicable to the event, as well as to the terms and conditions of the agreement between the PNW Section, PGA of America and the event.

NON-METAL SPIKE RELEASE: It is the requirement of the host clubs that all individuals using the host clubs golf courses wear spikeless/non-metal golf shoes. This requirement is a policy of the host clubs and is not a policy of the Ping Pro-Pro. The use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes may result in the participant slipping on wet or damp surfaces (inclusive of but not necessarily limited to turf area, wooden areas such as bridges and pathways, etc.) and reduced traction on non-level areas of the golf courses. As evidenced by the participant's signature on the front of this entry, the participant acknowledges that potential dangers relative to the use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes have been disclosed to the participant and participant agrees to assume the risk of sustaining injury arising from or attributable to the use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes at the host clubs premises. The participant here releases the Ping Pro-Pro and all persons affiliated herewith the Ping Pro-Pro from any and all claims for loss damage, inclusive but not limited to personal injury, whether or not caused by participant's use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes at the host clubs premises in connection with the event. The consideration for this release is the permission granted by the Ping Pro-Pro to the participant to participate in the golf tournament. This release binds not only the participant, but the participant's spouse, heirs, legal representatives and assigns.

By the application, an applicant consents to references to him and pictures of him and his play in any publicity, radio and television broadcasting and other exhibition or publication, including their use in any commercial manner.

ELIGIBLE PLAYERS: The term "eligible player" is defined, for this event, as: (1) PGA of America members (except those classified as "A-3", "F" or "Reserve"); (2) Eligibly employed PGA of America Associates.

FIELD: 56 Team Maximum: Open & Senior Divisions. Open Yardage – 6760 Senior Yardage 6335

In the event less than 15 entries are received prior to the Feb. 20 deadline the event will be cancelled.

If there are less than 8 teams entered in the Senior Division, all teams will play in the Open Division. **SKINS:** 100% of the Skin Pot will be returned to the participants; Skins will be paid by Division; In the event of no first round skins the pot will be distributed based on the second round; In the event of no skins for the event the money will be distributed into the payout of each division.

DRESS CODE: Contestants may not wear jeans, shorts, or skirts in the event.
